

### **Loss of Stations**

In the event that Thames E.M.S. was to suffer the loss of a station from a circumstance such as disaster, fire, flood etc. the following procedures will be followed:

- 1) Emergency services (911) will be contacted immediately to undertake rescue and extrication efforts as required.
- 2) The Duty Manager will contact the General Manager, or his designate, immediately.
- 3) If there is a loss of fleet and supplies, follow those contingency plans as well.
- 4) Call London CACC and advise, arrange to have displaced crews contacted by radio or pager. Standby's can be assigned to the station location.
- 5) Contact P.U.C., Hydro, Bell, etc. and advise of the situation.
- 6) Senior Administration will contact the station property owner and advise.
- 7) Senior Administration will contact the Manager of Emergency Services and advise.
- 8) Ensure security of building and supplies / equipment. The Duty Manager will organize security measures as required. Narcotics must be located and secured.
